

耶穌升天節的答唱詠選自聖詠第 47 篇。

這聖詠與前篇 46 和下篇 48 一氣呵成 出自同一位作 者:科辣黑的後裔。三篇聖詠都講述以民遭受苦難, 但上主激勵百姓保持信心與勇毅,上主必定救助。第 47 篇尤其指出將來整個世界都皈依天主,欽崇同一 的神;在默西亞來臨時,萬民只朝拜唯一的天主。教 會自古就用此聖詠歌頌升天的基督,作為聖言的實

按三篇聖詠的內容,和「科辣黑的後裔」的年代推論: 聖詠 46 至 48 篇應是以民分成南北兩國時 ,互相敵對 甚至交戰(詳見列下各章),因此鄰近的民族乘機侵 擾以色列地,企圖搶奪資源和控制歐、亞、非三洲陸 路的貿易。作者,即科辣黑的後裔,這家族原是耶京 聖殿的守衛(見編上9:19; 26:1-19 和編下 20:19),在 上主的感召下,把在南北兩國交戰時,到南北兩國相 繼滅亡和以民被逼充軍的情懷,寫成聖詠集中最清 逸、最真誠懇切的詩篇。

答句出自第6節(天主上升,有歡呼聲護送,上主騰 空,有號角聲相從)。若天主「上升」,須先「下降」, 這節暗示耶穌基督降生成人,並戰勝罪惡和死亡,完 成贖世的工程,然後輝煌地升天。其餘的詩節是讚美 和歌頌升天的基督至尊至聖,是整個宇宙的君王。

Youth Corner 12th May

Scripture: Mark 16:15-20

Observation:

In this week's Gospel, Jesus clearly commands his disciples to 'proclaim the gospel to every creature'. We are also presented with fantastic signs that will accompany those who believe, the driving out of demons, picking up snakes and miraculous healing. These signs still occur to this very day, with exorcisms taking place and the occasional healing miracle.

Application:

I want to focus on a miracle that happens closer to home and occurs much more frequently. The Eucharistic miracle. Whilst what we see very rarely changes, as it is the 'substance' and not the 'accidents' or physical characteristics of the bread and wine changing, occasionally, both the 'substance' and the 'accidents' change, with a recent example being in Legnica, Poland, with Professor Barbara Engel stating "The material was analyzed using UV rays with an orange filter and the results were univocal. We have identified myocardial fibres, typical of myocardial tissue with alterations that often appear during the agony." Jesus was in extreme agony when he died on the cross, let's never stop proclaiming the 'source and summit' of the Christian life, the Holy Eucharist.



Prayer:

Thanks God for sending down your son to us, so that we could be saved. Thanks for instituting the sacrament of the Eucharist, an instrument of grace that allows us to adore and receive you in the body. Amen.

ST MONICA'S The Ascension of the Lord - Year B

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

FIRST READING

Acts 1:1-11

In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven. He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them and tell them about the kingdom of God. When he had been at table with them, he had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised. 'It is,' he had said, 'what you have heard me speak about:

John baptised with water but you, not many days from now, will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.' Now having met together, they asked him, 'Lord, has the time come? Are you going to restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know times or dates that the Father has decided by his own authority, but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and then you will be my witnesses not only in Jerusalem but throughout Judaea and Samaria, and indeed to the ends of the earth.'

As he said this he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight. They were still staring into the sky when suddenly two men in white were standing near them and they said, 'Why are you men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky? Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven, this same Jesus will come back in the same way as you have seen him go there.'

of grace, given as Christ allotted it. It was said that he would:

When he ascended to the height, he captured prisoners, he gave gifts to men.

When it says, 'he ascended', what can it mean if not that he descended right down to the lower regions of the earth? The one who rose higher than all the heavens to fill all things is none other than the one who descended. And to some, his gift was that they should be apostles; to some, prophets; to some, evangelists; to some, pastors and teachers; so that the saints together make a unity in the work of service, building up the body of Christ. In this way we are all to come to unity in our faith and in our knowledge of the Son of God, until we become the perfect Man, fully mature with the fullness of Christ himself.

Jesus showed himself to the Eleven and said to them, 'Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all creation.
