那時候,梅瑟下來,將上主的一切 話和誡命,講述給百姓聽;眾百姓都 同聲回答說:「凡上主所吩咐的話,我 們全要奉行。」

弟兄姊妹們:

基督一到,就作了未來鴻恩的大司祭。他經過了那更大,更齊全的,不是人手所造,不屬於受造世界的帳幕;不是帶著公山羊和牛犢的血,而是帶著自己的血,一次而為永遠,進入了天上的聖殿,獲得了永遠的救贖。

如果公山羊和牛犢的血,以及母牛的灰燼,灑在那些受玷污的人身上,可淨化他們,得到肉身的潔淨,何況基督的血呢?基督藉著永生的神,已把自己,毫無瑕疵地奉獻於天主,他的血

豈不更能潔淨我們的良心,除去死亡 的行為,好去事奉生活的天主?

耶穌打發兩位門徒去尋找舉行 逾越節晚餐的地方,結果一切都和 耶穌所預告的情形完全一樣。這說 明在事件發生之前耶穌就知道了一 切。任何事情都不會使耶穌驚訝,祂 事先就已知道一切,因為祂和父密 切結合,接受父為祂所安排的一切。

耶穌舉杯也同樣地說了祝福的話語,希臘文「祝福」(Eucharistia)的原意就是「感恩」。最後晚餐中的這一個關鍵字,促使初期基督徒團體把紀念這個晚餐的禮儀稱為「感恩禮」。

杯中的酒本來就屬於慶節宴會 的一部份,但是,耶穌把酒視作「自 己的血 |和「新約的血」。「我的血」 和前面的「我的身體」相互平行呼 應;透過把杯遞給門徒的行動,耶 穌建立了一個新的 盟約:在耶穌的 血中、亦即在祂的死亡中,一個新的 盟約得以建立。這段經文也反映了 依五三11-12:「我正義的僕人…… 承擔了大眾的罪過,作罪犯的中保, 犧牲了自己的性命。」在這段先知書 的背景之下,我們特別看見耶穌死 亡的救援功效,同時也發現這個救 援的普世性幅度,天主的新子民,普 世性的子民因此出現在世上。透過 耶穌為眾人所流出來的血,產生了 一個新的盟約的團體。

基督聖體聖血節乙年讀經答唱詠選自聖詠116 篇。

這篇聖詠作者不詳,但由於詩文極具阿拉美語的特色,學者推論此詩應是充軍後以民回國後,甚至是兩約之間的作品。內容大約是因患重病,但又得痊愈,而藉這詩篇感謝天主。本詩明顯地分成上下兩段,上段(1至9節)是說明詩人對天主的愛,下段(10至19節)是伸述天主的忠實。彌撒答唱詠選讀的屬後段。

答句出自第13節(我要舉起救恩的杯爵,我要呼籲上主的名號),歷代的聖經學者都清楚指出,「舉起救恩的杯爵」出自聖殿的「和平祭」(詳見肋第3章和本主日讀經一),是具有宴會性質的祭獻;再引伸到新約教會的聖體聖事(見格前10:16)。

第15節(上主的聖者們的去世,在上主的眼中十分珍貴),詩文暗喻降生聖子的死亡(見路23:47)。

第16節(我的上主!我是你的僕役,你僕役是你婢女的兒子;你將我的鎖鍊給我開釋),聖 奧斯定註釋說:人蒙受聖子犧牲的恩寵,成了 上主的僕人,是聖教會(基督的淨配與婢女) 的兒女,並祈求藉基督所流的聖血而得寬恕。

第17和18節(我要獻給你讚美之祭,我要呼號上主的名字。我要在眾百姓面前,向上主還我的誓願),「向上主還願」原指往耶路撒冷聖殿獻祭,現范指所有在聖教會內的彌撒,不斷地朝拜和讚美上主,稱揚祂的救恩。

Scripture:Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26

Observation:

This week's Gospel describes the day of Jesus' last supper, the very last thing which Jesus ate before his death. But before the Supper begins preparations must be made, Jesus tells two of his disciples to go into the city and set the room up. This preparation is a mirror of the preparation of the Israelites in Exodus. In the Old Testament Moses on the behalf of God tells the Israelites to sacrifice a lamb and smear the blood on the front of the door on the night before they were to be freed from Egypt. The Gospel shares many parallels as Jesus tells the Disciples to make preparations for a meal on the day before they were to be saved from sin rather than from pharaoh's enslavement. The lamb from the Old Testament is Jesus in this story as he is the sacrifice that is required for us to be saved from sin, hence why he is named "The Lamb of God". Finally, much like the Jews who would celebrate the freedom from Egypt with the passover meal which emulates the original sacrifice of the lamb, we do much the same with the sacrament of the Eucharist, but we feast upon the eternal body of Christ. It is important for us to understand that Jesus very explicitly says "this is my body" and "this is my blood". When Jesus instituted this sacrament he was not being metaphorical he was being very literal. By proxy when the priest at mass does the same we should also take it literally. When you consume the host you aren't just eating a biscuit or a cookie that represents the bread, or is meant to simply remind us of Jesus, it is the body of Christ.

Application

The bible is often called the story of Salvation, much can be gained from reading the bible stories in a vacuum and discerning messages from them in isolation, however as I hope you can see from today's Gospel the stories of the bible interconnect from old to new Testament.

They even interconnect with us today. Next time you participate in the Sacrament of Holy Communion think about how this sacrament fits into our salvation from sin all the way back to the beginning of Genesis. The sacrament of Holy Communion is the culmination of God's Salvation plan from us, a plan which was laid out and begun all the way back in the Old Testament, for us. So when we consume the Eucharist and pray, meditate on this idea and thank God for giving us this Grace, a Grace which cost the sacrifice of his Son, Jesus.

Prayer

Dear heavenly father, I thank you for all that you have given us and the greatness of the sacraments through which we are able to take in your Grace. May you continue to bless us with the most Holy Gift of the Eucharist so that we might be saved and be able to live like you for all time. Amen

Entrance Antiphon

He fed them with the finest wheat and satisfied them with honey from the rock.

First Reading Exodus 24:3-8

Moses went and told the people all the commands of the Lord and all the ordinances. In answer, all the people said with one voice, 'We will observe all the commands that the Lord has decreed.' Moses put all the commands of the Lord into writing, and early next morning he built an altar at the foot of the mountain, with twelve standing-stones for the twelve tribes of Israel. Then he directed certain young Israelites to offer holocausts and to immolate bullocks to the Lord as communion sacrifices. Half of the blood Moses took up and put into basins, the other half he cast on the altar. And taking the Book of the Covenant he read it to the listening people, and they said, 'We will observe all that the Lord has decreed; we will obey.' Then Moses took the blood and cast it towards the people. 'This' he said 'is the blood of the Covenant that the Lord has made with you, containing all these rules.'

Second Reading Hebrews 9:11-15

Now Christ has come, as the high priest of all the blessings which were to come. He has passed through the greater, the more perfect tent, which is better than one made by men's hands because it is not of this created order; and he has entered the sanctuary once and for all, taking with him not the blood of goats and bull calves, but his own blood, having won an eternal redemption for us. The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer are sprinkled on those who have incurred defilement and they restore the holiness of their outward lives; how much more effectively the blood of Christ, who offered himself as the perfect sacrifice to God through the eternal Spirit, can purify our inner self from dead actions so that we do our service to the living God. He brings a new covenant, as the mediator, only so that the people who were called to an eternal inheritance may actually receive what was promised: his death took place to cancel the sins that infringed the earlier covenant.


Gospel Acclamation

Gospel Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover lamb was sacrificed, his disciples said to Jesus, 'Where do you want us to go and make the preparations for you to eat the passover?' So he sent two of his disciples,



saying to them, 'Go into the city and you will meet a man carrying a pitcher of water. Follow him, and say to the owner of the house which he enters, "The Master says: Where is my dining room in which I can eat the passover with my disciples?" He will show you a large upper room furnished with couches, all prepared. Make the preparations for us there.' The disciples set out and went to the city and found everything as he had told them, and prepared the Passover.

And as they were eating he took some bread, and when he had said the blessing he broke it and gave it to them. 'Take it,' he said 'this is my body.' Then he took a cup, and when he had returned thanks he gave it to them, and all drank from it, and he said to them, 'This is my blood, the blood of the covenant, which is to be poured out for many. I tell you solemnly, I shall not drink any more wine until the day I drink the new wine in the kingdom of God.' After psalms had been sung they left for the Mount of Olives.
