

本主日答唱詠選自聖詠第126篇。這是其中一 篇「昇階聖詠」(聖詠120至134篇,又稱「登 聖殿歌」)。是以民往耶路撒冷朝聖,特別是 到達聖殿時互相對唱的歌曲。有傳統說是聖殿 大門有十五級階梯,朝聖者每上一級就詠唱-首聖詠。作者卻不詳。今日的讀經完整地讀出 整首聖詠。

全詩大意是以民在波斯帝國君王居魯士的恩准 下,重返巴勒斯坦,結束八十年被充軍巴比倫 的日子(見厄上、下)。詩人藉這歌稱謝天主 的洪恩,並求天主把四散的以民,收集回來。

答句出自第2至3節(那時,我們滿口喜氣盈 盈,我們雙唇其樂融融。那時,外邦異民都讚 歎不已:上主向他們行了何等奇事!上主向我 們行了偉大奇蹟,我們的確也覺得滿心歡 喜。),聖母讚主曲亦引用了這一節(見路 1:49),表達了以民歸國完全出自天主的大 能。

第4至6節(上主,求你轉變我們的命運!就像 乃革布有流水的澆淋。那含淚播種的人,必含笑 獲享收成;他們邊行邊哭,出去播種耕耘,他們 載欣載奔,回來背着禾捆。),詩人以荒漠降雨 和農作豐收來描述以民回國的欣喜。這也是所 有人得蒙主恩的正常反應。

Scripture: John 8: 1-11

Observation:

In this week's gospel, we again see the awesome grace of Jesus but also the importance of self-awareness, examination of conscience and confession. We see that the scribes and Pharisees attempted to catch Jesus in a trap so they can lay some charges against Jesus. They brought a woman who was accused of adultery to Jesus. Now it does not actually say whether this was factual or just all accusations in the scripture but nonetheless, Jesus "reverse-UNO'ed" them and asked whoever is without sin to throw the first stone. One-by-one, they all left, and in the end, Jesus is the last one left standing. The obvious message here is that none of us are without sin and thus we are not to start condemning others for their sins as this is God's power. However, the other significant detail here is that Jesus is the only one left standing at the end, he is the only one without sin, the one true judge, yet he sets her free and tells her to not sin again. This is Jesus defeating sin and death for us.

Application:

We often try to find faults in others, after all, humans love some dramas and gossip. In doing so, we are blinded to our own unfaithfulness to our faith and to God. We are not God, not Jesus, it is not our role to condemn each other of their sins. We must love everyone, and treat them fairly, no matter what they have done. This is easier said than done. Can you treat a proven criminal, a drug addict, a bully the same way you would treat your friends? And can you recognize your own sins and seek forgiveness. During the rest of the lent season, I would like to challenge you to contemplate on this, go through the examination of conscience and then go to confession.

Prayer:

Dear Jesus, thank you for your goodness and righteousness. You are the one true Judge and I pray that we always remember this so we can humble ourselves before you, and have the strength and courage to own up to our sins so that we can start seeking for your help in turning away from these sins and temptations. Amen.

SECOND READING PHILIPPIANS 3:8-14 I believe nothing can happen that will outweigh the supreme advantage of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For him I have accepted the loss of everything, and I look on everything as so much rubbish if only I can have Christ and be given a place in him. I am no longer trying for perfection by my own efforts, the perfection that comes from the Law, but I want only the perfection that comes through faith in Christ, and is from God and based on faith. All I want is to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and to share his sufferings by reproducing the pattern of his death. That is the way I can hope to take my place in the resurrection of the dead. Not that I have become perfect yet: I have not yet won, but I am still running, trying to capture the prize for which Christ Jesus captured me. I can assure you my brothers, I am far from thinking that I have already won. All I can say is that I forget

the past and I strain ahead for what is still to come; I am racing for the finish, for the prize to which God calls us upwards to receive in Christ Jesus.
