中華殉道諸聖及真福慶日,答唱詠選自聖詠第 16 篇。

原文有標明是「達味金詩」,相信是達味君王所撰,但「金詩」一詞卻頗廢解。有聖經學者認為是達味君王最高水準的珍貴詩篇(故稱為「金詩」),亦有學者說是「刻在石碑上的經文」之意,更有學者未作定論。聖詠集內只有六篇標明是「達味金詩」(詠 16; 56; 57; 58; 59; 60)。

按內容,這篇聖詠似乎是達味蒙難時(可能是撒上26章的記載),受了天主的啟示,領悟到將來默西亞,甚至聖教會所受的苦難,抒於歌詠,同時亦預言默西亞的復活,和聖教會怎樣光榮天主。因此按字面,是達味向上主詠讚,按整體卻超越了達味的經驗,而是天主預言默西亞的苦難和復活。聖伯多祿和聖保祿兩位宗徒,都曾引這篇聖詠來證明耶穌是默西亞 並按經上所載 由死者中復活(見宗2:25;13:35)。

答句出自第1節(天主,求你保祐我,因為我只投 靠你),這是教會經常向上主呼求的禱詞。

第5節(上主,你是我的產業,是我的杯爵,我要得你的基業,有你為我守著),達味用「產業」來描繪他與上主的緊密關係,並預示基督與教會,互相成為對方的「產業」。

第9至10節(因此我心高興,我靈喜歡,連我的肉軀也無憂安眠。因為你絕不會將我遺棄在陰府,你也絕不讓你的聖者見到腐朽)清晰地預示默西亞的苦難與復活,宗徒和初期教會都一直這樣詮釋,甚至犧牲自己的性命來見證福音的真理。

第11節(請你將生命的道路指示給我,唯有在你面前有圓滿的喜悅,永遠在你右邊也是我的福樂), 這節指出聖教會的使命:就是引領世人皈依天主。

Scripture Luke 10: 1-12, 17-20

Observation

There are a few passages in the Bible which directly reference the evangelical mission Jesus entrusts his disciples with. These can be found across the Synoptic Gospels (of Matthew, Mark, and Luke) in which you will find many parallels which provide unique angles, perspectives, and context to key events in the life and ministry of Jesus. For example, the story of the calming of the storm can be found in all three Synoptic Gospels.

Similarly, Jesus' teachings in today's passage can also be found in unmistakeable likeness in Matthew 10 and Mark 6, highlighting the important message Jesus shares with his followers: to go out and proclaim the Good News boldly. However, it is only in Luke's account (writing to a broader, Gentile audience) that we see an emphasis placed upon Jesus' warning of the perilous nature of their task, cautioning them that they will be like 'lambs among wolves.'

In a society where religion is increasingly subject to scrutiny and accusations of bigotry, the occupational hazards of the Christian mission are perhaps more publicly apparent now than ever before. However, Jesus urges us to remain steadfast and lead all conversations with peace, confident that the Peace of God will strengthen us and remain with us at all times.

Application

In the coming week, let us reflect on the mission that Jesus has entrusted to each and every one of us. In our own lives, how does Jesus call us to proclaim the Good News?

For some, it could be sharing a personal testimony or inviting a friend to church/youth group. For others, it could be living out your faith through practical actions such as acts of service or prayer.

Let us pray for a conscientious heart and courageous soul so that we can live fearlessly in the service of our neighbour. As St Paul wrote in his letter to the Romans (Chapter 10):

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' But how can they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how can they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone to preach?"

Prayer

Heavenly Father, pour forth your Holy Spirit to inspire me with these words from Holy Scripture. Stir in my soul the desire to renew my faith and deepen my relationship with your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, so that I might truly believe in and live the Good News. Open my heart to hear the Gospel and grant me the confidence to proclaim the Good News to others. Pour out your Spirit, so that I might be strengthened to go forth and witness to the Gospel in my everyday life through my words and actions. Amen.

Entrance Antiphon

Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith.

First Reading Revelation 7: 9-17

I, John, had a vision of a great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue. They stood before the throne and before the Lamb, wearing white robes and holding palm branches in their hands. They cried out in a loud voice:

"Salvation comes from our God, who is seated on the throne, and from the Lamb."

All the angels stood around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They prostrated themselves before the throne, worshiped God, and exclaimed:

"Amen. Blessing and glory, wisdom and thanksgiving, honor, power, and might be to our God forever and ever. Amen."

Then one of the elders spoke up and said to me, "Who are these wearing white robes, and where did they come from?" I said to him, "My lord, you are the one who knows."
