青年組曲奇義賣 BAKE SALE

7位青年組成員正準備參加今年 11 月在墨爾本舉行的澳洲天主教青年節。為資助他們的朝聖旅程,青年組將於下星期日,9 月 21 日,9 時和 11 時半彌撒後,舉行曲奇義賣。請大家支持。

光榮十字架慶日的答唱詠選自聖詠第78篇,是「阿 撒夫」所撰的詩歌。「阿撒夫」應該不只是一個 人,而是出自肋未支派(即在聖殿内服侍天主)的 -個家族。他們所寫的詩歌(共十二篇,即詠50; 73至83)多是歷史的追憶,用辭雄壯高尚,意義卓 越,比喻和典故特多。大約都是南國末年至瑪加伯 時代的作品。原詩頗長(共七十二節),教會只選 讀其中幾節。

答句出自第7節,但應與第5和6節一起讀(他曾在 雅各伯頒佈了誡命,也曾在以色列立定了法令;凡 孫,叫那未來的一代也要明悉,他們生長後,也要 告知後裔,叫他們仰望天主,不忘記他的功行,反 而常要遵守天主的誡命),詩人提醒以民天主早已 把法律啟示出來,凡記起和遵守的人必獲祂的恩

第1至2節(我的百姓,請傾聽我的指教。請你們側 耳,聽我口的訓導。我要開口講述譬喻,我要說出 古代謎語),詩人闡述天主與以色列民,在西乃山 所訂的盟約的精神。

第34和35節(上主擊殺他們,他們即來尋覓上主: 他們回心轉意,也熱切地尋求天主,也想起天主是 自己的磐石,至高者天主是自己的救主),這是以 民剛入福地時的情況:順境時人民忘記天主,逆境 時才曉得向天主祈求救援(詳見整部民長紀)。

第36至38節(但是他們卻滿口欺騙,以舌頭向他說 出謊言。他們的心對他毫無誠意,不忠於與他所立 的約誓。但是他卻慈悲為懷,赦免罪污,沒有消滅 他們,且常抑止憤怒;也未曾把自己全部怒火洩 露),詩人毫無掩飾以民多次離棄天主,但上主仍 憐愛以民,並含蓄地預示默西亞帶來的寬恕和救 援。這就是耶穌基督十字架所顯示的救恩。

Scripture: John 3:13-17

Observation: In today's Gospel reading we are invited by Jesus to reflect upon the purpose of his incarnation on Earth. The Gospel reminds us that God did not have to send his only son down to Earth to die. He did so because he loved us so much that we wished for us to be saved so that we may enjoy heaven in Communion with him. The Gospel alludes to a story in Exodus where the Israelites are punished by God for their disobedience, and God tells Moses that if any Israelite wishes to be saved they must look upon his staff with a snake on top. There are clear parallels with this Old Testament story and Jesus, we are condemned as the Israelites were because of our sin, and the only way out of that is through Jesus. In a similar way to how the Israelites could not simply kill the snakes, for us to be delivered from sin we must look to the radical love of Jesus, who died on the cross for us.

Application: A common objection to the belief in Catholicism by many atheists is the notion that - why can't we just be "good people", why do we need God and why do we need to worship Jesus at mass. This Gospel answers this for us, it reveals that it is impossible for us to truly be good and sinless as Jesus has been. It sounds harsh but the truth is the because of original sin we don't deserve to go to heaven, because heaven is perfect, but we are so clearly not. But it is the radical loving sacrifice of Jesus which allows us to enter the kingdom of God, it is through him and only him that we can attain salvation. That is why we must pray, that is why we must have faith because it is through prayer and faith that we can form a relationship with God. That is not to say that we should reject good works as Catholics, part of a true faith in Jesus is good works. But we cannot remove Jesus and his sacrifice if we want to obtain eternal life, if we want to build a relationship with God so that we can spend eternity with him.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, I thank you for even though I am a sinner, you sent your only son down to Earth for us so that we may be exalted and enter into your love. May we work tireľessly to love you as you love ús, and I pray that should I fall, your love would carry me into the light of your mercy and forgiveness. Amen

ST MONICA'S The Exaltation of the Holy Cross

14th September 2025

Entrance Antiphon

We should glory in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom is our salvation, life and resurrection, through whom we are saved and delivered.

First Reading Numbers 21:4-9

On the way through the wilderness, the Israelites lost patience. They spoke against God and against Moses, 'Why did you bring us out of Egypt to die in this wilderness? For there is neither bread nor water here; we are sick of this unsatisfying food.'

At this God sent fiery serpents among the people; their bite brought death to many in Israel. The people came and said to Moses, 'We have sinned by speaking against the Lord and against you. Intercede for us with the Lord to save us from these serpents.' Moses interceded for the people, and the Lord answered him, 'Make a fiery serpent and put it on a standard. If anyone is bitten and looks at it, he shall live.' So Moses fashioned a bronze serpent which he put on a standard, and if anyone was bitten by a serpent, he looked at the bronze serpent and lived. Responsorial Psalm Ps 77

(R.) Do not forget the works of the Lord!

- 1. Give heed, my people, to my teaching; turn your ear to the words of my mouth. I will open my mouth in a parable and reveal hidden lessons of the past. (R.)

Second Reading Philippians 2:6-11

The state of Jesus was divine, yet he did not cling to his equality with God but emptied himself to assume the condition of a slave, and became as men are; and being as all men are, he was humbler yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross. But God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names so that all beings in the heavens, on earth and in the underworld, should bend the knee at the name of Jesus and that every tongue should acclaim Jesus Christ as Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Gospel JOHN 18:15-20 Jesus said to Nicodemus:

'No one has gone up to heaven except the one who came down from heaven, the Son of Man who is in heaven; and the Son of Man must be lifted up as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him. Yes, God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life. For God sent his Son into the world not to condemn the world, but so that through him the world might be **saved.'** The Gospel of the Lord

Communion Antiphon

When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself, says the Lord.

















耶穌和尼苛德摩談話時,先向他講述看見天國的條件是必須得到「由上而來」的永遠的生命(三1-13)。今天的福音一開始耶穌繼續闡明,得到永生的方法就是相信「被高舉的人子」(三14-15)。從整部福音來看,「高舉」的意義就是人子上升到天父那裡,而這個深刻信仰內涵具有一個外在的、每個人都能辨識的的記號—「十字架」。

由此我們看見信仰的弔詭性,我們必須克服對十字架的憎惡,相信被釘死的人子 — 耶穌 — 就是天主子,相信這一切原是出自於天主的計劃,才能得到永遠的生命。藉由和戶籍紀中梅瑟高舉銅蛇的故事(戶二一6-9)相比較,若望福音告訴基督徒,人本來是被死亡之毒綑綁束縛,而失去了永遠的生命,卻由於「被高舉」的耶穌基督,而重新得到天主恩賜的永遠的生命。

與天主的愛相對的是「世界」,根據若望團體的看法,這個世界本來只應該受到審判,因為整個人類都完全敗壞了。但是,天主卻派遣祂的獨生子來到世界上,並不是為了審判世界,反而是為了拯救一切經由信仰接受祂的人。由於信仰不能強迫,而是人自由的抉擇,因此,人們也可能選擇不信。既然是每人自由的抉擇,當然也得自行承受其後果。抉擇的重要性在於它決定了審判,不信的人是自己審判了自己。

這段經文的每一句話都十分珍貴, 清楚地表達天主對世人的愛。原本存在 於天主和世界之間的鴻溝,被祂死在十 字架上的獨生子所填平。在祂救援世人 的計畫中,天主唯一向世人要求的只是 信仰。

耶穌曾由天降下,被高舉在十字架上,天主的仁慈大愛因此而啟示出來,使人得以「重生」,在審判時得到拯救,得到和天主一起生活的永遠的生命。「重生」並非人性智慧或努力的結果,而是聖神的恩賜和信仰的奧秘。

耶穌運用舊約中「銅蛇」的故事向「以色列的師傅」(尼苛德摩)解釋他被高舉在十字架上的意義。被綁在木棍上的銅蛇曾經是以色列人在曠野中的救援記號,然而他們並不是被銅蛇所拯救,而是天主的仁慈所拯救。天主願意拯救迷途者,這是祂永遠的愛的奧秘。誰如果向天主開放自我,就生活在「光」中,實行真理。
