

本主日答唱詠選自聖詠 121 篇。

這是其中一首「昇階聖詠」(聖詠第120至134 篇,共十五篇),是以民來耶路撒冷朝聖時,準 備登上聖殿山時詠唱的詩歌。另一說法是:相 傳聖殿正門有十五級石階,以民每上行一階就 詠唱一首聖詠。無論如何,都是以民前往耶京時 的祈禱。按本篇的內容,似是出自在外流亡多年 的以民,終於重返家鄉時的心聲,故此詩應是重 建聖殿時的作品(詳見《厄斯德拉上、下》)。 本日彌撒唱出整首聖詠。

答句出自第2節,但應與第1節齊讀(我舉我目 向聖山瞻望,我的救助要來自何方?我的救助 來自上主,他創造了天地宇宙)。此節描述以民 的天主是創造宇宙的唯一真神,絕不像異民無 能的偶像。

第3至4節(他決不讓你的腳滑倒;保護你的也 決不睡覺。看,那保護以色列者,不打盹也不會 睡着);詩人用另一角度描述天主:祂不像人會 疲累,也不似偶像般只懂呆立;祂是時時醒寤, 不斷眷顧世人的真神。

第5至6節(上主站在你的右邊,作你的護衛和 保安。白天太陽必不傷你,黑夜月亮也不害你), 「站在你的右邊」指天主的疼愛和珍惜;「太 陽、月亮」是指天主對人是不分晝夜的眷顧。 第7至8節(上主保護你於任何災患,上主保護 你的心靈平安。上主保護你出外,保護你回來, 從現在起一直到永遠的世代),詩人說出天主對 人無微不至的眷顧,並引導眾人過正直的生活 (即出外、回來),達至永生。

Youth Corner 19th October

Scripture:

Luke 18: 1-8 – "The Parable of the Persistent Window"

Observation:

The parable Jesus tells in today's Gospel can be described as very thought-provoking underdog story. Back in Jesus's time, widows were usually found at lower end Jewish society, with very little influence or privilege. Judges, on the other hand, could be as corrupt as they wanted to be and rarely worried about the consequences. This is especially true of the judge depicted in today's Gospel, who is so uncaring and unjust that you'll wonder how he even ended up as a judge in the first place. Even though the parable is short, we can still infer a lot about his character; he is selfish, unsympathetic, and the complete opposite of the perfect and infinitely loving judge that God is. In the end though, the judge still ends up changing his mind to help the seemingly powerless widow with her appeal, not because he felt sorry for her, but because she was so persistent that he feared he'd be physically attacked.

Today's Gospel warns us about the end times, when most people will be so consumed by Earthly concerns that they abandon God. This isn't sometime in the far future – it's actually happening now. As Catholics in this era of growing distrust in God and his plans, we will undoubtedly face many trials and sufferings, but we mustn't lose our faith. Just like the widow in today's Gospel, we may sometimes feel powerless, but remember: Jesus will never forget about you, and he hears every single one of your concerns. This is why it's hears every single one of your concerns. This is why it's important to pray, not just when you feel like you need something from God, but constantly, even when those around you fall away from him. Jesus's question at the end of today's Gospel, "will he find faith on Earth?" is to get the triple when all hears is lest will very size. get you to think: when all hope is lost, will you give up or will you keep clinging to God? Because if even a selfish and unfair judge agrees to help such a persistent widow, God will most definitely help you if you just keep persisting.

Prayer:

Heavenly father, help me to be as faithful and persevering as the widow in today's Gospel. Help me to continue trusting in your perfect sense of justice, even when the world around me grows cold. FIRST READING Exodus 17:8-13

The Amalekites came and attacked Israel at Rephidim. Moses said to Joshua, 'Pick out men for yourself, and tomorrow morning march out to engage Amalek. I, meanwhile, will stand on the hilltop, the staff of God in my hand.' Joshua did as Moses told him and marched out to engage Amalek, while Moses and Aaron and Hur went up to the top of the hill. As long as Moses kept his arms raised, Israel had the advantage; when he let his arms fall, the advantage went to Amalek. But Moses arms grew heavy, so they took a stone and put it under him and on this he sat, Aaron and Hur supporting his arms, one on one side, one on the other; and his arms remained firm till sunset.
